

TARRYALL ICE FISHING TOURNAMENT

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entrants must have a valid Colorado fishing license and habitat stamp to participate and all fishing regulations will apply. All fish must be caught in a legal manner on rod and reel or ice tip-up.
2. All participants must check-in at the weighing station at Potato Gulch Campsite #4. **Check-in begins at 5:00am and ends at 8:00am. No fishing or holes may be drilled before 6:00am.** If you fail to check-in prior to fishing you will disqualify yourself from the tournament. Participants may choose their spot on the ice beginning at 6:00am. Anyone found drilling or fishing prior to the start time will be disqualified. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!**
3. You may not leave the Tarryall Reservoir area once the tournament has begun or you will be disqualified.
4. You will be disqualified for party fishing – this is an individual tournament – anyone with you **MUST** be entered in the tournament (this would include spouses, friends and/or children) **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
5. Decisions of the Judges are final.
6. **All fish must be weighed in by 2:00pm to qualify.** You may have your fish weighed before the 2:00pm deadline but you may not change fish after you weigh in. It is your responsibility to pay attention to the clock and give yourself ample time to make it to the weigh-in station on time. Once fish have been weighed they may not be removed from the check-in station
7. Please pack out all litter.
8. There will be **NO REFUNDS** for any reason. Contest will be held regardless of weather.
10. Once you weigh in you must be present to win – no one will be allowed to collect your prize for you. – If you are not present you forfeit
11. Anyone being unsportsmanlike can and will be disqualified from the tournament. Tournament officials and/or Division of Wildlife personnel will be on the ice throughout the tournament.
12. Names and or likeness of all winners may be used by Sponsor for promotional purposes with no compensation to winner.
13. Employees of Chaparral Park General Store, their spouses and immediate family not eligible to win cash prizes or door prizes.
14. Awards and door prize drawings will be held immediately after final weigh-in.
15. All decisions will be made by tournament officials.
